


City of Plantation
Minutes of a Regular Meeting of Council Members

The following are minutes of a meeting of the City of Plantation conducted at 6:15pm on October 23rd, 2019 at 2502-C Hermitage Way, Louisville, KY 40242. In attendance at the meeting: Mayor Becky Peak, CM Nita James, CM Holly Law, CM Kathryn Ray, CM Susan Schneider, CM Roy Weller. On roll call, there was a quorum. Also present was Arielle Hummel, City Clerk who recorded the minutes. All in attendance stood and recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Minutes Motion to approve August minutes by Susan Schneider, seconded by Holly Law. Vote in favor was unanimous.
- Motion to approve September minutes by Susan Schneider, seconded by Roy Weller. Vote in favor was unanimous.
- Financial Report Charlie Veeneman reviewed updated MRA Fund and General Fund financials for period ending June 30, 2019. Financials reflected first quarter insurance premium taxes received, property taxes received, and grant money returned. Motion to approve the financial report by Holly Law, seconded by Kathryn Ray. Vote in favor was unanimous.
- Old Business Mayor Becky Peak discussed city wide yard sale participation and turnout. Reminded council of Trick or Treat date and mentioned posting of information in October Newsletter.
- New Business Mark Madison presented city infrastructure plans and recommendations to council. Mark Madison also discussed possible solutions to parking issues within the city.
- Other Reports City Attorney John Singler reminded council that he would be presenting information on cell tower ordinance in January.
- City Clerk Arielle Hummel reported approximately 90% of property tax payments have been received. Business License Fee letters and address research being conducted.
- Mayor Becky Peak discussed future meetings and scheduling speakers for 2020.
- Adjournment With no further business and without objection, the Mayor closed the meeting at 7:08pm.
